

Guidance for Candidates Applying to Enter Examinations October 2022

Introduction

Candidates are advised to read the information in this guidance document **before** completing the Application Form. The guidance provides information on the application process and relevant timelines.

Completing the Application Form

Please complete all of the information required on the form. Please write clearly as the information provided will be used by the IFE in order to communicate with you and to process your examination arrangements.

With reference to the timetable indicated, be aware of any time clashes with exams and please notify us of such if you choose two exams taking place at the same time. Exam fees can be found on page 2 of the form. For Preferred Exam Centres, refer to the list on page 3 of the application. The application form also contains information about where to send the form upon completion.

The IFE recommends that you retain a copy of your completed Application Form as the form includes a summary of the examinations that you have entered and the times when the examinations will take place. It also includes the Terms and Conditions for examination candidates.

Information provided to the IFE

When you complete the application form, you will be asked to provide your consent for the IFE to hold your personal information. The IFE holds minimal personal information about you and the information is held only to enable us to provide your examination service. You will be asked to provide your consent for the IFE to hold your information for qualification purposes when you complete your application form.

Terms and Conditions for Candidates

You must read the Terms and Conditions prior to submitting your application form and tick the box on the form to confirm your acceptance of these. **The IFE is not able to accept applications without this confirmation from candidates.**

Payment of Examination Fees and Charges

For all applicants wishing to enter the exams via the SA Branch, your application form and payment should be sent to the SA Branch for processing before 25 July 2022. Payment must be made in South African Rands. Please take note that only residents of South Africa have to pay vat, all neighbouring states are vat exempt.

The SA Branch will not accept any entries after 25 July 2022. Please contact the SA Branch as soon as possible to avoid the risk of missing the deadline. Contact details for the SA Branch: Email: adminstaff@ife.org.za Tel: +27 11 788 4329. Website www.ife.org.za No application will be processed unless it is accompanied by the appropriate fees. NB Foreign students: if you submit payment by SWIFT transfer (which can take up to 5 working days to appear on a bank statement), then your application will not be processed until payment has been received. Payment made in this manner must be received **before** the final closing date 25 July 2022. Please note that the bank charges for foreign payments are for your account and the full exam fee amount must reflect in our account. MoneyGram or Western Union payments must be agreed in advance by special arrangement with the South African Branch, and must be sent 3 working days **before** 25 July 2022. If any payments are rejected, we will make contact to request an alternative method of payment. If no further payment is received, the IFE will cancel the examination entry and no examination papers will be provided to the examination venue.

Late Entries

The IFE South Africa Branch will endeavour to accept and process late applications, up to and including **22 August 2022**. However, a late entry fee of ZAR2,139 vat incl. will be applied to all applications submitted after the closing date of 25 July 2022.

Candidates should note that the IFE is not able to guarantee that candidate requirements submitted as late entries can be met, as not all examination venues will be able to accommodate changes or additional candidates.

Candidates who are awaiting their results from March 2022 examinations will not be subjected to the late entry fee, and their exam registration and payment needs to reach our office by **22 August 2022**.

Applying for Reasonable Adjustments

Candidates who have disabilities or particular assessment needs such as dyslexia are able to apply for reasonable adjustments. All requests should be submitted using the appropriate form. Examination Centres

For a list of provisional exam centres, please see page 3 of the examination application form. Enquire at the IFE SA if you are uncertain. Please be aware that this list is not definitive as sometimes venues change due to unforeseen circumstances or may not be able to run (e.g. insufficient number of candidates), or may have a maximum capacity. Wherever this is the case we will endeavour to inform those affected as promptly as possible. It may also be possible to place a candidate at a venue that does not appear on the list; however this can sometimes lead to additional charges for the candidate/s. Candidates should contact the IFE SA if they wish to discuss alternative venue options.

<p>Late Entry Fee Applied to entries received after 25 July 2022 and up to 22 August 2022</p>	<p>R2,139 vat incl. per candidate The late fee is added to the standard entry fees. Late entries will be accepted only where the IFE can accommodate the candidate at an appropriate examination centre. The last date for accepting late entries is 22 August 2022. Please note: the late entry fee will be waived for candidates who took examinations in March 2022 and who are awaiting results prior to booking.</p>
<p>Refund of Entry Fees Available up to 22 August 2022</p>	<p>Candidates who change their minds and wish to withdraw from examinations may ask for a full refund of their entry fee up until 22 August 2022. Refund requests should be made to the SA Branch office on email: adminstaff@ife.org.za Please note: this is a final cut-off date and no refunds will be made after this date.</p>
<p>Withdrawing from Examinations 23 August 2022 up to 12 September 2022</p>	<p>Please see Special Considerations policy which sets out the limited situations in which a deferral arrangement may be possible and the supporting documentation which will be required by the IFE in order to progress the request. Where the request is approved, an administration fee of ZAR814.20 vat incl. will be charged for each examination paper deferred.</p>
<p>Applying for deferral arrangements 13 September 2022 up to 26 October 2022</p>	<p>Please see the Special Considerations policy which sets out the limited situations in which a deferral arrangement may be possible and the supporting documentation which will be required by the IFE in order to process the request. Where the request is approved a fee of ZAR897 vat incl. will be charged for each paper deferred (L2C and L3c) and ZAR1,062.60 vat incl. (L3D and L4D) (Note: where candidates defer four papers, the deferral fee will be ZAR2,001) Note: The IFE does not accept deferral applications after the closing date.</p>
<p>Amendment to Examination Entries</p>	<p>Candidates may amend their examination entry without further charge up to 22 August 2022. After 22 August 2022, the IFE will try to meet requests for changes to papers/venues. However, changes may not be possible at this stage and the IFE reserves the right to make an administration charge, e.g. where additional postal charges are incurred.</p>

What happens after I have applied?

If you have submitted your application directly to the IFE SA office, we will email you to confirm receipt. Once your application has been processed we will send written acknowledgement approximately mid-September via email detailing the examinations booked and the exam centre chosen. Please be aware that during busy times, entries may take up to a week to be acknowledged. If in doubt, contact us by telephone or email.

If you receive any notification from the IFE that the application cannot be processed, please respond immediately. If you do not contact us, you are at risk of not being entered for your requested examination.

Examination confirmation letters will be emailed to all candidates along with information about the exam venue that they have been allocated by mid-September 2022. We urge every candidate to read this letter carefully and to advise us of any discrepancies immediately.

Note to all candidates: If you have not received your emailed letter by the 20 September (not before), please contact us and we will email a copy.
